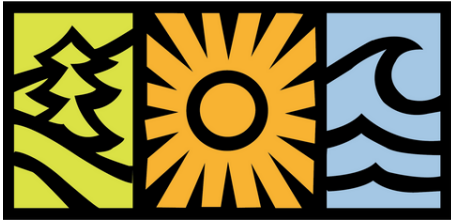

# Worm Wranglin'

## WHAT IS WORM WRANGLIN'?

At Worm Wranglin', volunteers join us at our home base to help care for our worms. Our resident composting worms help us teach San Diegans about the value of vermicomposting (composting with worms). Our worm bins act as a demonstration site, a nursery for providing worms to community members who compost at home, and a source of nutrient-rich castings for use in gardens. Help care for these amazing compost critters, promote sustainability in our community, and have fun learning all about how vermicomposting can be implemented at the household level.

## WHAT WILL VOLUNTEERS DO AT THIS OPPORTUNITY?

Volunteer activities may include the following: separating worms from their castings, sifting castings, feeding worms and making "worm burritos", building new worm beds, and moving breeder worms to new homes. In other words, all things worm care!

## ANY EXPERIENCE OR REQUIREMENTS?

- All levels of experience are welcome!
- Wear clothes that can get dirty and closed-toe shoes, a hat, and sunscreen are recommended.
- Work gloves are provided on-site.
- Volunteers must be at least 5 years of age.
- Volunteers under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or adult.
- Volunteers under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian register for them.

**Other things to note:** This is hands-on work with worms and other compost critters! If you are scared of our worm friends, please remember we will be handling them! We can offer an alternative garden activity for those who aren't worm fans. This activity is outdoors. We may also do some lifting of up to 25 pounds.

## WHAT IS BUILD AND BEAUTIFY?

Build and Beautify is a day for volunteers to get involved with the development of our home base by preparing and implementing site improvements to support our programs. In joining us for this activity, you will help beautify our grounds, creating a space for engaging our community in our sustainable offerings.

## WHAT WILL VOLUNTEERS DO AT THIS OPPORTUNITY?

- Gardening and pruning
- Staging rain barrels
- Maintaining and building demonstration sites that help teach topics in sustainability
- Chipping and moving mulch
- Beautifying our grounds including some trash pickup
- Preparing and implementing site improvements and new programs
- Painting

## ANY EXPERIENCE OR REQUIREMENTS?

- Attire: Wear clothes to get dirty in! Gloves will be provided but feel free to bring your own.
- Experience Needed: All levels of experience are welcome!
- Age Requirements: Must be aged 16 and up. All volunteers under the age of 18 will need a parent or guardian to fill out the registration form on their behalf.

## PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 will secure your event date. Full payment of the total cost must be received to confirm your booking. Failure to complete payment may result in the rescheduling of your event.

A full refund (not including deposit) is available for cancellation up to 2 weeks before the scheduled event and/or if Solana Center needs to cancel due to unforeseen circumstances.

A 50% refund (not including deposit) is available for cancellation within 2 weeks of the scheduled event. Alternatively, your event can be rescheduled pending availability.
